2023 “The Grinch that stole Christmas” Springfield Christmas Parade Rules

1. Entries must reflect a holiday theme, or the theme chosen by the Parade Committee. Entries may be historical, humorous, or modern in design, as long as they are in good taste. Remember a large part of the audience will be children.
2. **NO OTHER SANTA IS ALLOWED.** Santa Claus and his sleigh are provided by the Parade Committee. **Please communicate this to all those participating.**
3. Please identify only the sponsors and / or builder of your Entry. No other advertising is permitted.
4. Floats **MAY NOT** exceed 10 ft. in width and 13.5 ft. in height.
5. Entries may use sound amplification for musical purposes, but not for addressing the audience - no speeches or campaigning please! Music / sound / public-address amplification systems must be no louder than 80-90 decibels.
6. The parade will be held rain or shine. Dress warm, be safe & have fun!
7. All participants should be informed about COVID protocol(s) from Lane County Health Regulations:

8. All those participating in the parade are should “...maintain 6’ physical distance” and “wear face coverings.” We also encourage proper hand washing and/or hand sanitizing. **You are responsible to ensure that all social distancing guidelines/regulations are being adhered to.**

Before the parade -

1. Each Entry will be given a parking/staging number for parade staging. Time for Entry registration will be given by the Parade Committee by November 25st (1 week prior to the parade). A staggered entry time is required as a means of ensuring safe entry into the staging area.
2. Staging area opens at 9am. Staging area is on Olympic Street, between 21st Street and 28th Street. **Entrance into the parade entry staging area is only through the Olympic and 28th checkpoint.** You will not be permitted to enter any other point of the parade route. **Do not** drop off participates or non-participating vehicles through this point.

Please communicate this to anyone who is operating a vehicle and will be in need of accessing any of the staging area.

3. You are responsible for notifying participants of the given Entry number to avoid confusion in locating the Entry staging area.
4. Olympic Street is limited to floats/entries and traffic that is dropping off materials or people. No parking will be permitted.
5. Roll call of all Entries will be conducted at 12:30pm. Once this is complete, any Entries that have not followed the registration process will be eliminated from the parade. **Parade will start promptly at 1 p.m.**

During the Parade:

1. For the safety of all, no materials may be thrown along the parade route. This includes: candy, flyers, literature, etc. However, individuals walking alongside entries may hand out items. Violations of this rule will result in removal from the parade.

2. Parade speed is a maximum of 5 miles per hour. Entries who falter may be asked to step aside and let others pass.
3. Dress warmly and prepare for any kind of weather. Bring extra blankets or warm clothing, especially for children.
4. Animal entries (horses, etc.) - you are responsible - **be prepared to clean up** after your own animals both **before leaving the staging area** and **during the parade route**. Violators can be fined for such violations and the Parade Committee is not liable.

End of parade

1. At the end of the parade please remember to pull forward on Pioneer Parkway E to disband.
2. **Pull past B Street** before starting to unloading passengers from Entries. Pull as far away from Main Street as possible, so that other entries can also pull off. Pioneer Parkway E will be closed off to all traffic other than parade Entries, please utilize side streets for the picking up of passengers.**Following this process will ensure all participants remain safe.

There will be a special map and exit for horses – please look for that the day of the parade

3. **Do not** stop in the middle of the Pioneer Parkway E, pull off to either side.

** Stopping in the middle will cause congestion and delay the parade progress.

Please note: all entries must be received by November 7th 2023. Entries must observe all applicable rules and regulations or entry will be barred from the parade. The Parade Committee reserves the right to remove from the parade, either prior to assembly, at assembly or at any time during the parade, any entrant not conforming to the rules and regulations or any entrance refusing to follow instructions of police or parade officials. * The Parade Committee must approve all entries before entering the lineup. Failure to adhere to the parade rules may result in a one-year suspension from participation in the parade.*

Entry cancellations: no refunds for cancellations on Parade day. If contact is not made, it is assumed that participates are forfeiting their entry into the parade.

In case of severe freezing temperatures, snow or ice, the parade may be postponed.

Release:

I give the Parade Committee the rights and permission to copyright or publish photography or video images of this parade. This may be included in whole, parts, composite or distorted characters and form. In conjunction with my own or fictitious name, reproduction Fair in color or otherwise, for art, advertising, trade or any other lawful purpose whatsoever.

I hereby waive any right that I may have to inspect and or approve the finished product or the advertising copy that may be used in connection therewith, or the use to which it may be applied.

I agree, for all participants in this parade entry and hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless, the Parade Committee, it's planning committee, sponsors, and volunteers from all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of my participation in the 2023 "The Grinch that stole Christmas".
